I have the honour to inform you that the three COSCAP programmes in the Asia Region will host the 3rd Asia Regional Aviation Safety Team (ARAST) meeting on 16 - 18 March 2010 at the ICAO Asia and Pacific Office, Bangkok, Thailand. This important meeting is being opened to all States/Administrations in the Asia and Pacific Regions.

It is my pleasure to invite your State/Administration to participate in the 3rd ARAST meeting in the spirit of regional cooperation.

Member States / Administrations participating in the three COSCAP Programmes in the Asia Region may have already received a similar invitation to the 3rd ARAST meeting from their respective Chief Technical Advisors / Programme Coordinators.

The Asia Pacific regional States / Administrations may be aware that the three COSCAPs have established Safety Teams in their respective sub-region for some years now and have been relentlessly pursuing safety interventions and identifying areas of concern to flight safety that may be unique to the region or require emphasis within the region. To that end they have been working very closely with the regulatory bodies, airlines, manufacturers and industry groups to ensure that safety interventions are implemented as deemed appropriate.


The three Asia COSCAP safety teams have since been combined to improve efficiency, reduce duplication of effort and provide a wider forum for the exchange of best safety practices. The ARAST Terms of Reference have also been expanded to include responsibilities related to the implementation of the Global Aviation Safety Plan/Roadmap (GASP/R). The previous ARAST meeting has conducted a review of the first five Global Safety Initiatives/Focus Areas (GSI/FA) which have a primary focus for States/Region. The outputs from the ARAST meetings are subsequently presented to the respective Steering Committees for approval.
